

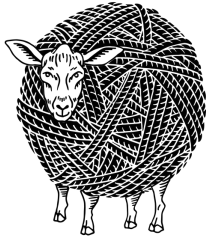

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## 25 DAYS OF SCARVES

## SCARF 04

### MATERIALS:

- 1 ball of Bernat Velvet
- Size N crochet hook (10mm)

### DESIGNER NOTES:

The classic ripple stitch! One of my grandmothers used to make an afghan for each of the grandkids in either ripple stitch or chevron. Mine was made with different shades of blue. This pattern does not use the whole ball of Bernat Velvet; you'll have approximately a third of the ball left over. Here's a great video already on YouTube by Bella Coco to help you learn the *ripple stitch*.

### ABBREVIATIONS:

- **CH** - chain
- **SC** - single crochet
- **DC** - double crochet
- **ST(S)** - stitch(es)
- **TOG** - together
- **REP** - repeat

### NOW LET'S CROCHET!

**CH** 133.

**Row 1:** Starting in the second chain from the hook, **SC** 132.

**Row 2:** Now we'll start the ripple stitch! This is the set-up row and I broke it down into 7 steps.

1. **Ch** 3, turn, and **DC** into the same stitch the chain is in.
2. **DC** in the next 3 sts.
3. \***DC** 2 sts tog, twice. (These are decreases.)
4. **DC** in the next 3 sts.
5. **2DC** into the next st, twice. (These are increases.)
6. **DC** in the next 3 sts.
7. **Rep** from \* until the last 4 sts. **DC** into the next 3 sts. **2DC** in the last st.

**Rows 3-8:** This is the row you will repeat for the rest of the pattern. It's almost identical to Row 2. I've broken it down again.

1. **Ch** 3, turn, and **DC** into the base of the chain.
2. **DC** in the next 3 sts.
3. \***DC** 2 sts tog, twice. (These are decreases.)
4. **DC** in the next 3 sts.
5. **2DC** into the next st, twice. (These are increases.)
6. **DC** in the next 3 sts.
7. **Rep** from \* until the last 3 sts. **DC** into the next 3 sts. **2DC** into the chained 3 sts from the previous round.

**Row 9:** **SC** 132.

**Weave** in ends and stay warm!

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
