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25 DAYS OF SCARVES

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MATERIALS:

- 3* skeins of Wool Folk Hygge (2 in Color A, 1 in Color B)
- 40" US 17 (12mm) circular needles
- Ring or stitch marker to mark beginning of pattern

DESIGNER NOTES:

I started this piece wanting to make a triangular shawl but only using two skeins of Wool Folk Hygge. I made it up row by row, sometimes frogging a row right after I had knit it. By the time I hit row 44, I realized I was running out of yarn to make it the size I wanted and decided to join it in the round. *You don't actually need 3 full skeins of Hygge - you only knit 1 row in Color B and then bind off (scraps will do)!

ABBREVIATIONS:

- **CO** - cast on
- **K** - knit
- **P** - purl
- **PM** - place marker
- **REP** - repeat
- **RND(S)** - round(s)
- **ST(S)** - stitch(es)
- **YO** - yarn over

NOW LET'S GET KNITTING!

CO 3.

Row 1: K1, yo, k1, yo, k1. (5 sts)

Row 2 (and every even row through 44): Knit all stitches, even the YOs.

Row 3: K1, yo, k3, yo, k1. (7 sts)

Row 5: K1, yo, k5, yo, k1. (9 sts)

Row 7: K1, yo, k7, yo, k1. (11 sts)

Row 9: K1, yo, k3, yo, k3, yo, k3, yo, k1. (15 sts)

Row 11: K1, yo, k4, yo, k5, yo, k4, yo, k1. (19 sts)

Row 13: K1, yo, k5, yo, k7, yo, k5, yo, k1. (23 sts)

Row 15: K1, yo, k6, yo, k9, yo, k6, yo, k1. (27 sts)

Row 17: K1, yo, k7, yo, k11, yo, k7, yo, k1. (31 sts)

Row 19: K1, yo, k4, yo, k21, yo, k4, yo, k1. (35 sts)

Row 21: K1, yo, k5, yo, k23, yo, k5, yo, k1. (39 sts)

Row 23: K1, yo, k6, yo, k25, yo, k6, yo, k1. (43 sts)

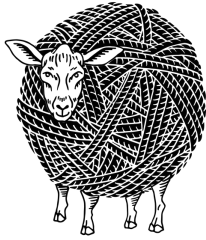
Row 25: K1, yo, k7, yo, k27, yo, k7, yo, k1. (47 sts)

Row 27: K1, yo, k8, yo, k14, yo, k1, yo, k14, yo, k8, yo, k1. (53 sts)

Row 29: K1, yo, k9, yo, k15, yo, k3, yo, k15, yo, k9, yo, k1. (59 sts)

Row 31: K1, yo, k10, yo, k16, yo, k5, yo, k16, yo, k10, yo, k1. (65 sts)

Row 33: K1, yo, k28, yo, k7, yo, k28, yo, k1. (69 sts)



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Row 35: K1, yo, k22, yo, k7, yo, k9, yo, k7, yo, k22, yo, k1. (75 sts)

Row 37: K1, yo, k23, yo, k27, yo, k23, yo, k1. (79 sts)

Row 39: K1, yo, k24, yo, k29, yo, k24, yo, k1. (83 sts)

Row 41: K1, yo, k25, yo, k31, yo, k25, yo, k1. (87 sts)

Row 43: K1, yo, k26, yo, k33, yo, k26, yo, k1. (91 sts)

Round 1: When you've knit to the end of Row 44, bring the tips of your needles together as if you were knitting a loop. Join in the round by purling the first stitch of Row 44 (which is now the first stitch of Round 1).

Round 2: K.

Round 3: P.

Round 4: K.

Round 5: P.

Round 6: K.

Round 7: P. Cut Color A.

Round 8: Attache Color B; k.

Bind off by purling each st.

To finish: I wanted the front of the capelet to close a little higher than it did so I sewed the front closed. I had about a 1.5' (45 cm) left of Color A so I used some of it to seam together approximately the bottom 5" (12 cm) of the V shape in the front of the capelet. Weave in ends and stay warm!
